Bruce Schneier – Secure your information



When you send sensitive information over the Internet such as your banking or credit card details how much faith do you have in the security of the websites you use? How easy is it for someone to hack into your emails, your online transactions

and steal your money or worse, your identity?

Internationally-renowned security guru Bruce Schneier, listed in the top three most powerful voices in security by SOA World Magazine (just a smidgen behind US Deputy Secretary of Defence William Lynn III) can tell you, and his answers might disturb you. Bruce is a frequent guest on television and radio in the United States. He writes regularly for international media including The New York Times, The Guardian, The Washington Post, The Bulletin of the Atomic Scientists. His newsletters and blogs are read by more than a quarter of a million people.

One of his 11 books is Applied Cryptography which explains how the arcane science of secret codes actually works and was described by Wired Magazine "as the book the National Security Agency wanted never to be published."
